A forestry earthworks management plan must identify the environmental risks associated with the earthworks and provide measures to avoid, remedy, or mitigate the adverse effects of the activity on the environment; and contain the details required by Schedule 4; and be in place at least 20 working days before the earthworks begin; and if the earthworks are required for a salvage operation, be in place 2 days before the earthworks begin. The forestry earthworks management plan must be provided to the relevant council on written request. The council may request that the forestry earthworks management plan be provided annually. Material amendments to the forestry earthworks management plan must be documented and dated, and the relevant council must be advised that an amendment has been made. The amended plan must be made available to the relevant council on request. In subclause (4), material amendment means any significant change to the location of forestry roads, forestry tracks, or landings, or changes to the matters required by subclause (2)(a) that would significantly change the methods used to manage environment effects. If a forestry earthworks management plan is required under subclause (1), earthworks must be carried out in accordance with the plan. 
